Alterations of hormone receptor status in hormone related tumors and their clinical implications on prognosis and therapy; chemoprevention of breast cancer; familial/hereditary breast cancer and BRCA1/2 mutations; clinical implications of the inactivation of tumor suppressor genes in solid tumors; innovative molecular scanning techniques for the detection of gene mutations; treatment of breast cancer, melanoma, lung, colorectal and gynecological cancers; supportive and palliative care in cancer patients. Prof. Marchetti invented the electronic-dolometer, an electronic device to measure pain perception and quality of life in cancer patients. Moreover, he coordinates a supportive care research group, that has published several papers and has produced clinical recommendations on symptom treatment in the framework of simultaneous care.
